Privacy Notice

The Bury St Edmunds Chess Club takes your privacy seriously and will use your personal information only for chess club activities. This policy explains what personal information we collect, how we use that information and who it may be shared with. What information do we collect about you?

To run the club efficiently, we routinely collect information about club members and those interested in becoming club members. This includes details such as names, addresses and contact details.

Who has access to my information?

To allow communication with the club membership, for the organisation of teams and to assist in administration (including the collection of membership fees), your details will be shared with team captains and club officers. Efficient communication within teams sometimes also requires that your details be shared with other team members.

Club membership lists, along with game and match results (but not contact details) are shared with the leagues in which we participate, and via them with the English Chess Federation (ECF). These are publicly available online and in print. Locations of publication include but are not limited to:

If you become a team captain or club officer, your name and contact details will need to be shared more widely, including with the leagues in which we participate. Read on for details.

Captains

To allow squad members and opposing captains to contact you about upcoming matches, your name and contact details will be shared with your squad and with the league in which your team competes. Publication of, and access to, your details will be governed by the league's own privacy policy.

Club Officers

Your name and contact details will be shared on the club website and, where relevant, with the leagues in which we participate. Publication of, and access to, your details will be governed by the league's own privacy policy.
