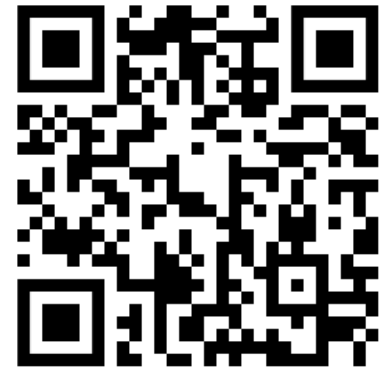


Setting the Clocks (DGT 2010)

Fischer Timing: Option 18

Suffolk League: 1:15 + 15 sec/move
BACL: 1:10 + 15 sec/move

Standard Timing: Option 5

Both Leagues: 1:15 (30 moves) + 15 min Quick Play Finish

League / Competition	Fischer	Standard
Suffolk League	1h 15m + 15s/move	1h 15m (30 moves) + 15 min
Div 1 and 2	Default option	Used if both players agree
Div 3, Cup and Plate, u125, u145 etc	Used if both players agree	Default option
Norfolk & Suffolk Cup	Mandatory	Not permitted
Bury Area Chess League	1h 10m + 15s/move	1h 15m (30 moves) + 15 min
Div 1 and 2, Roger Goldsmith	Default option	Used if both players agree
Div 3	Normal option	Used if either player requests it

Basic Operation

- On/Off – button underneath
- Changing settings – the +/- buttons (left)
- Confirming selection (and move to next step) – the tick button (right)
- Start/Pause the clock – middle button

Stepwise Instructions

- Turn on underneath
- Select option 5 or 18 as appropriate (use the +/- buttons to adjust then the tick button to select)
- Check if displayed options are as required
- If so, press the centre button to accept them
- If you aren't sure, repeatedly press or hold down the tick button to cycle through all the settings. For Fischer they may show a start time reduced by the increment, which will be added to both sides when the clocks are started.
- If not, alter the settings one digit at a time. Adjust the flashing digit using the +/- buttons and confirm when finished using the tick button to move to the next digit.
- For standard timing you will see a '2' on the left-hand clock to indicate the second period, then on the right the length of that period.
- Once set, position the 'paddle' ready for white to press after making their first move
- When ready, press the centre button to start the clock

Made a mistake? Turn off and on again using the button underneath
